Instructions for New Website

There is now a new website for the St Kentigern College rowing photos:

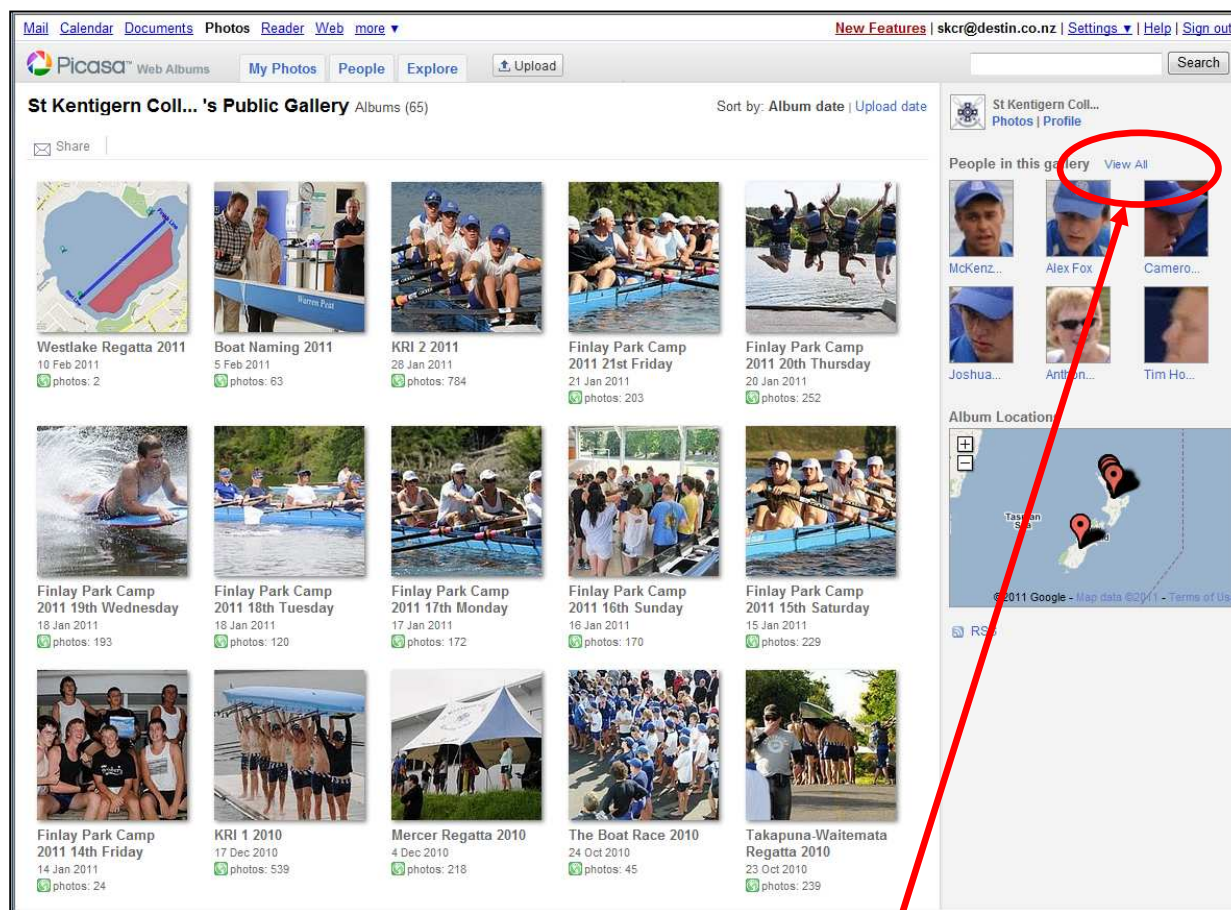

This website has a number of advantages over the previous photo website.

1. The resolution of the photos is 2.5 times higher.
2. Faces can be tagged so you can search for people by name.
3. The location of the photos is shown on google maps.
4. Capacity to handle a high number of hits - we had a very high number of hits following the last few events.
5. Greater reliability.
6. Camera information recorded for each photo.

The Main Page

The main page (called a gallery) looks like this.

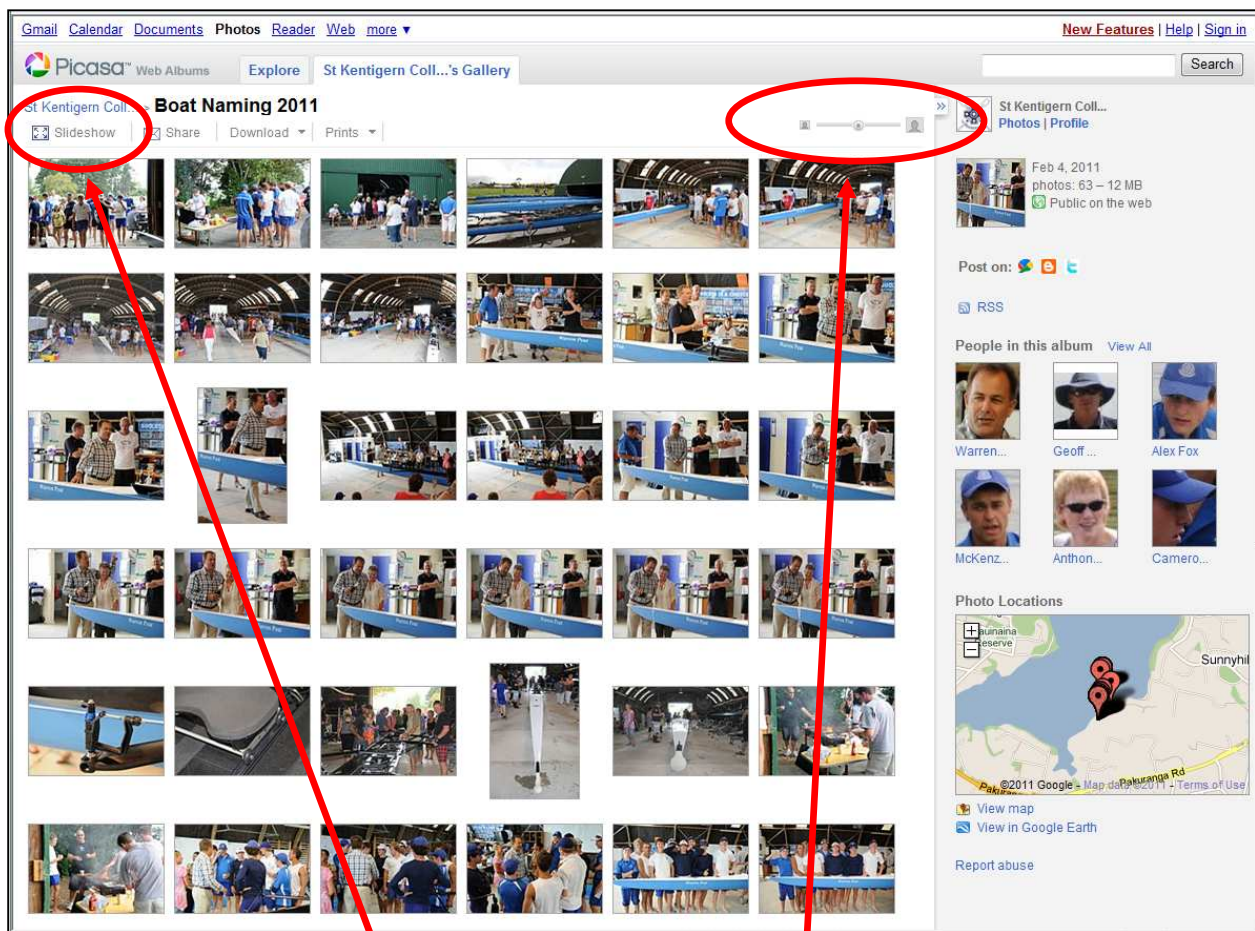


This page shows an image for each event in chronological order starting with the most recent event first. By clicking on the image you will be taken to the album for that event. Some events like Maadi will have multiple albums.

On the right hand side of the screen the pictures of the six people with the highest number of tagged photos are shown. You can see all tagged people in the gallery by clicking on [View All](#)


If you click on a person you will see all photos in the entire gallery in which that person has been tagged.

Album View



When you open the album you will see a thumbnail for each photo, the top 6 tagged people in the album and a map showing the locations where the photos were taken.

You can alter the size of the thumbnails using the slider    at the top right of the main window.

To view the photos click on the  **Slideshow** button at the top left or click on an individual photo.

If you click on a person on the right hand side of the screen you will see all photos within that album in which that person has been tagged.

Photo Location



When viewing the individual photos you will see:

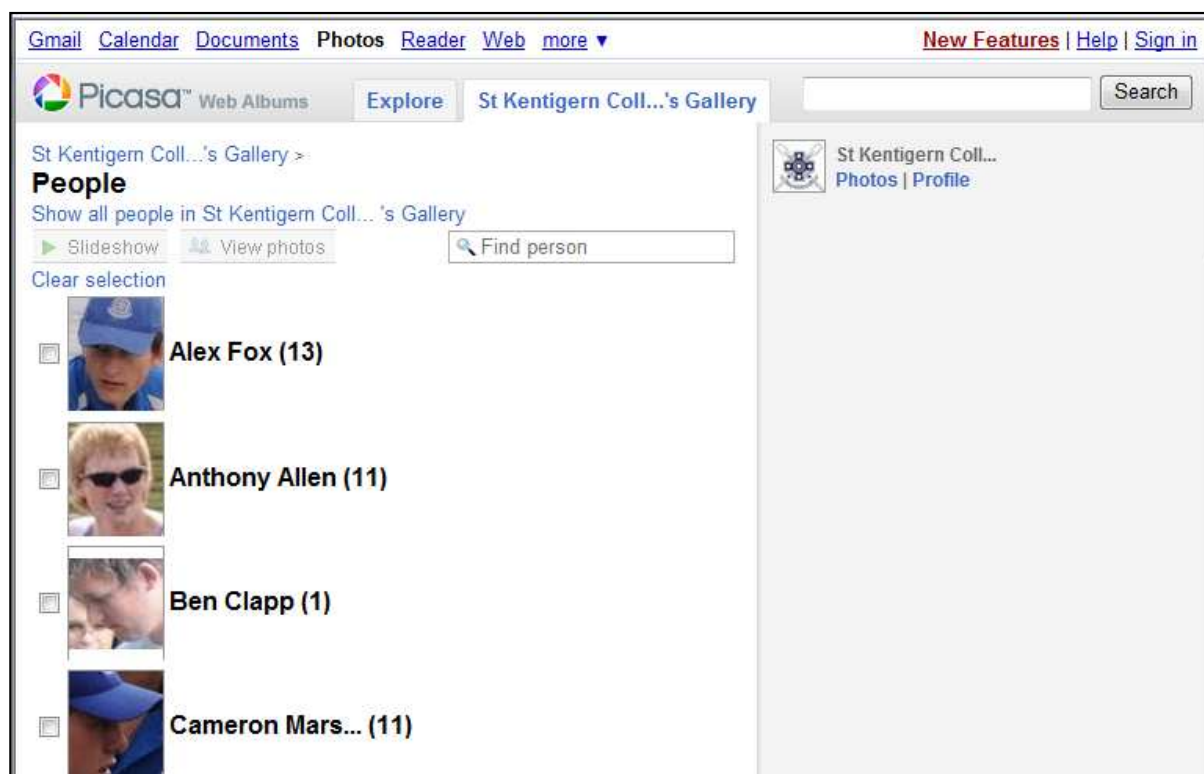
- A larger view of the photo
- Detailed photo information such as the camera settings
- A list of the people tagged in the photo
- The location where the photo was taken shown on GoogleMaps.

If you move your mouse over the photo it will highlight the tagged people.

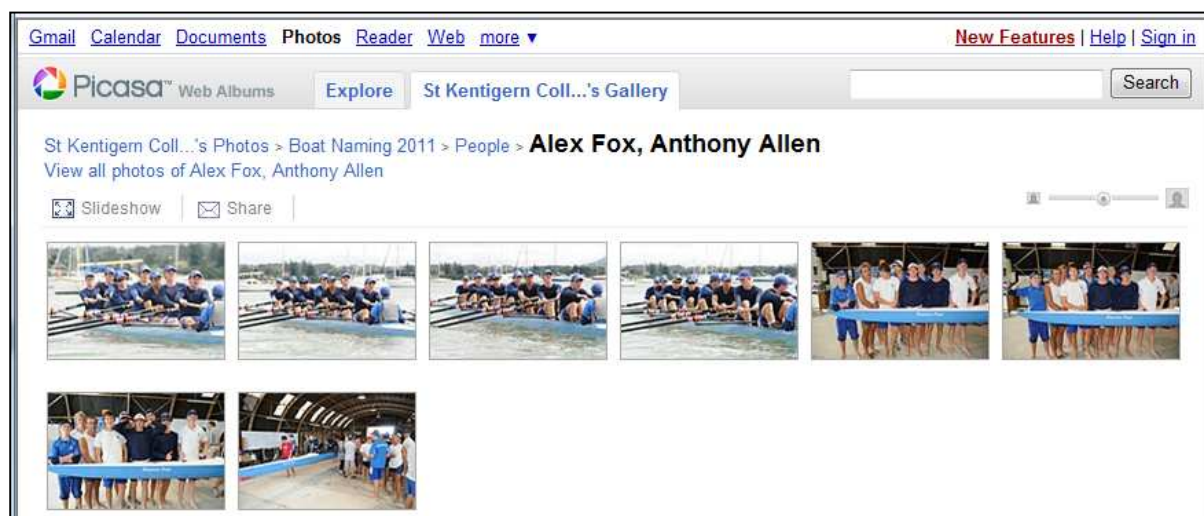
Face Tagging

The website uses facial recognition software to match the people in new photos to faces of people that have previously been identified. It does a fantastic job given the large number of people, expressions and headgear. A list of unmatched faces is created which Steven reviews periodically attempting to tag as many people as possible thereby enhancing the ability of the software to make further automatic matches. Currently approximately 50% of the 16,000 faces have been tagged.

When you select the [View All](#) option on any page you will see a list of all people tagged in photos in the gallery or album.



You can click on a person to view all the photos for that person or select multiple people to find any photos that contain all of the selected people e.g. if you select Alex and Anthony you will get all photos containing both Alex and Anthony.



As wonderful as face tagging is there are a few limitations:

- You can not select the photo used as “your” face.
- Unless a face is either facing towards the camera or at a slight angle then facial recognition is unlikely to work.
- Sometime faces are incorrectly tagged. If you find any errors then please email the details to steven.fox@destin.co.nz. At this stage please do not send through information about untagged photos. There are too many to deal with 😊
